

# Introductory Shearing Course



26<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> May 2008  
9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> December 2008

**Cost includes lunch, and travel expenses**

Participants should be at least 16 years old and must be capable of lifting and handling stock. Please remember that shearing is physically demanding.

You will need to bring the following equipment

- A full kit of shearing gear including combs, cutters & hand-piece
- Hand-piece must be fitted with a worm drive
- A minimum of 2 combs (comb size – 94 short bevel)
- 6 cutters, oilcan & oil, brush, wash tin
- Suitable shearing clothing, moccasins & towels

NOTE: One of the combs you bring to the course should be a new one, untouched. The other comb should be a used comb, preferably borrowed from a shearer. The cutters you bring should be good, but not necessarily new. Combs & cutters may be any make but must be of the concave, straight gear type.
