The FMG Taratahi scholarship aims to achieve the following:

## Objectives

- Maintain a strong link between FMG and Taratahi Agricultural Training Centre with the promotion of both organisations.
- Promote further tertiary education for those entering the agriculture sector.

## Criteria

- Enrolled in a New Zealand Certificate in Agriculture Level 3, one year, full-time programme - Sheep and Beef or Dairy option.
- Enrolled at Taratahi's Wairarapa Campus in Masterton.
- Shows passion for New Zealand's rural sector.

## Selection process

1. Applications are open from 1<sup>st</sup> February 2018 – 28<sup>th</sup> February 2018.
2. Interviews take place for shortlisted applicants in March.
3. Taratahi staff hold face-to-face interviews. Those shortlisted are required to attend an interview.
4. Taratahi staff recommend and agree on scholarship winners with FMG.
5. Applicants are notified of the scholarship winners by end of April 2018.

## Payment

- Three students will receive \$1,000 each.
- Payments will be made into the student's account at Taratahi.
- Payment will be a credit towards students' fees at Taratahi.
